VINI BIANCHI

Vernaccia di San Gimignano, Toscolo, Tuscany, Italy, 2012 – 90 Points	38
Bright gold-tinged yellow, white blend. Saline nuances complicate ripe tropical fruit and peach aromas. Finishes structured and persistent with a building sweetness. Acidic and flavorful.	
Viognier, White Knight, Clarksburg, CA, 2013 – 91 Points	29
Delightful aromas of apple, nectarine, and lime zest are highlighted by sweet honeysuckle notes. The palate is full of peach and tropical flavors which smoothly transition into a soft, juicy finish.	
Pinot Grigio, Cantina di Cortaccia, Alto Adige, Italy, 2012 – 89 Points	38
Aromas of freshly cut flowers, green apple, lime and peach leap from the glass. The creamy texture is brightened by lively acidity.	
Pinot Gris, Panther Creek, Willamette Valley, OR, 2013 – 92 Points	38
Bright, crisp , and clean with a tropical fruit core. This wine is laced with green apple, honey, and wet stone, and beautifully balanced with a velvety mouth feel. Delicious alone or pairs well with light to medium fare.	
Sauvignon Blanc, Babich, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2013 – 88 Points	38
Bright herbs, fennel, black currant, and lemon on the nose and palate. Clean, fresh, and tropical with fruit from several vineyards situated throughout Marlborough. It finishes medium-long with a good balance.	
Sauvignon Blanc, Wrath "Ex Anima", Monterrey, CA 2013 – 90 Points	44
A powerful bouquet shows off a classically grassy nose with undertones of grapefruit and celery leaf. On the palate, minerality lingers alongside poached pear and peach. Refreshing and light, yet full of flavor.	
Sauvignon Blanc, Medlock Ames, Sonoma County, California, 2013 – 91 Points	50
Bright citrus aromas of ripe grapefruit and Meyer lemon are complimented by tropical notes of pineapple, guava, and a hint of boxwood. The acidity provides a crisp, fresh finish.	
Riesling, Anew, Columbia Valley, WA, 2012	34
Opening with aromas of bright fruit, subtle spice, and citrus. Offers a harmonious blend of pure fruit, flavor, heightened aromatics, and balanced acidity. Expressive flavors of fresh peach and a hint of spice.	
Soave Classico, Bolla, "Tufaie", Veneto, Italy, 2010	36
Delicate and floral with a dry, medium body. Well balanced, compliments oysters, shellfish, and risotto with seafood.	
Chardonnay, Magnolia Grove, California, 2013	34
Fermented in stainless steel tanks with a portion in French American oak, lending a rich and creamy mouthfeel. Supple on the palate with notes of pineapple, ripe peach, lemon zest, oak, and vanilla.	
Chardonnay, Sonoma Cutrer, Russian River, CA 2013 – 91 Points	44
Fruit aromas of delicious golden apple, pear and white peach are accented with toasted nuts, oak spice, a hint of vanilla, and a touch of butter. The creamy richness is balanced with a bright acidity.	

VINI ROSSI

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Ciccio Zaccagnini, "Tralcetto", Abruzzi, Italy, 2011 – 91 Points	42
Soft, fruity red with dried berries and hints of fruit cake. Full body, ripe tannins, and a delicious finish. An opulent and pleasing wine.	
Chianti Classico, Tenuta di Arceno, Siena, Italy, 2011 - 92	46
The nose exudes candied black cherries, licorice, and spices with subtle notes of lavender and violets. Big, rich, supple tannins fill the senses and carry flavors of ripe plums, blackberries on the vine, and hints of vanilla. All this power is framed by a firm acidity and white pepper, tobacco finish.	

VINI ROSSI

- Malbec, Llama, "Old Vine", Mendoza, Argentina, 2013 – 88 Points** 42
Rich, ruby-purple color that boasts elegant flavors of blackberries, ripe plum, and robust spices with good balance and structure. Earth and sweet soil on the palate. Red currants and dust on the nose.
- Super Tuscan, Collazzi Liberta, Giogoli, Italy, 2012 – 90 Points** 46
Full body with light **tannins**. Aromas and flavors of tart cherries, plum, peach, berries, and minerals. Crisp, silky, long finish.
- Pinot Noir, Deloach, Russian River, CA, 2012 – 90 Points** 38
Intriguing with baking spice aromas, leading to a full palate of plum and **raspberry** flavors and edged with a pleasant minerality. Its body and balanced acidity make it a perfect accompaniment to a wide variety of foods.
- Pinot Noir, La Crema, Willamette Valley, OR, 2013 – 90 Points** 55
Focused acidity, earthiness and vibrant fruit emphasizes balance with supple texture. The nose is **complex** with hints of violets, star anise, and marionberry (an Oregon native), while the palate displays more brambly fruit, coffee bean, and candied orange zest.
- Red Zinfandel, Seghesio, Sonoma County, CA 2013 – 92 Points** 48
A lively, zesty red that offers **bright** cherry and tarragon aromas with layered flavors of tantalizing raspberry, nutmeg, and cracked black pepper. A small amount of Petite Sirah is added into the wine for added complexity.
- Red Zinfandel, Peachy Canyon Westside Zin, Paso Robles, CA 2013 – 88 Points** 41
Intense **aromas** of allspice, truffle, fig, and brown sugar meet with fresh black cherry and blueberry on the palate. A carefully balanced wine with elegant tannins that is bright and fresh with a long, smooth finish.
- Syrah, Andrew Murray Tous les Jours, Santa Ynez Valley, CA 2013 – 94 Points** 42
Aromas of cherry, blackberry, lavender and a white pepper wow factor on the very inviting, **florally** driven nose. The wine looks silky in the glass, and flavors of black cherry, anise, violet and oregano are easily accessible to a wide variety of palate preferences.
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Roots Run Deep, "Educated Guess", Napa Valley, CA, 2012 – 89 Points** 46
Rich, ripe and focused with a juicy blackberry and cherry fruit, milk chocolate, and dusty notes all tied together with a creamy French vanilla middle and a lingering finish.
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Stag's Leap Wine Cellars, "Artemis", Napa Valley, CA, 2011 – 90 Points** 72
Intriguing **aromas** of red currant and cranberry mixed with hints of vanilla, and dried herbs. Soft entry with dried cherry, blackberry, currant and savory herb flavors on the palate. Medium bodied mouth feel with round, satin-like tannins.
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Robert Craig "Affinity", Napa Valley, CA, 2012 – 92 Points** 92
A Bordeaux inspired wine which is a blend of the left bank five, cab sauv, merlot, cab franc, petit verdot, and Malbec. Inky and purple in color, hints of mocha, assorted black fruits, and spices. **Pairs** with braised meats, hearty pastas, and summer evenings on the patio.
- Shiraz, Penfolds, "Thomas Hyland", South Australia, 2012** 34
A buoyant, fresh style that contains plenty of juicy blackberry fruit aromas and flavors, chocolate, ripe **tannins**, and some savory oak nuances. Distinctive spice notes and typically rich and well defined fruit characteristics.
- Merlot, Opolo Vineyards, Paso Robles, California, 2010** 42
This delightful wine offers a **bounty** of rich, ripe cherry, plum, and berries coupled with subtle oak overtones. Chocolate and earth on the nose. Well balanced with soft tannins, lively fruit and natural acidity, this wine has a smooth mouth-feel and alluring aftertaste.
- Merlot/Corvina Blend, Gran Passione, Veneto, Italy, 2013 – 88 Points** 42
Intense red-purple color, tending towards amber with ageing. The wine is full-bodied with good structure. There's an admirably fine balance between soft tannins and acidity. Generous palate of ripe red and black fruits, considerable length.
- Red Blend, Hey Mambo, California, 2012 – 90 Points** 32
A melding of cinnamon croissant, nutmeg, and blueberry swirls its way to a **rhythmic** beat across the palate. Rich and wonderful depth showcasing flavors of black currants, molasses, tart black cherry, plum sauce, toasted dill, and blackened marshmallow.
- Red Blend, Cuvee Le Bec, Beckman Vineyards, Santa Ynez, CA 2012 – 90 Points** 42
Opulent flavors of grenadine, cherry, and strawberry rhubarb unfurl in the mouth and usher a lively core of red licorice, lavender, and earth. The **finish** is big with sweet tannins, lingering cherry flavors, and well balanced acidity.
- Bordeaux Red Blend, Cain Concept, Napa Valley, CA, 2010** 112
A robe of deep, dark purple and the scent of cassis and cocoa. rich soft fruit earthy, berry fruit, dusty tannins, touch of peppercorn, and a creamy texture
- Bordeaux Red Blend, Opus One, Napa Valley, CA, 2011 – 92 Points** 287
The 2011 Opus One expresses fresh aromas of bright fruit, herbs, bay leaf, and cassis which give way to subtler **notes** of black tea, and white pepper. A brilliant, precise wine that offers a satiny finish and a slight grip of tannins at the close.
